Zakat-ul-Fitr زكاة الفطر

Zakat-ul Fitr £5.00 (this year) is equivalent to the value (cost) of 2kgs of Wheat Flour.

Every Muslim is required to pay Zakat-ul-Fitr (including for the new born) at the conclusion of the month of Ramadhan as a token of thankfulness to Allah (SWT) for having enabled us to observe fasts. It's purpose is to purify those who fast from any indecent act or speech and to help the poor and needy.

It is best paid during the month of Ramadhan so that the deserving people get it in time for their Eid celebrations.

Please remember:

All Zakat is the right of the deserving people and must be given to them accordingly. It is feared that we may be associated with those people who eat fire in their bellies (as described in Surah Al-Nisa' Verse 10).
